Location

One of a kind and undoubtedly one of the best beach hotels in Kerala, this delightful place is set in a palm grove, just back from an unspoiled and safe beach. Situated in the wonderfully unexploited area of North Kerala, near the mighty fort at Bekal, it is beautifully positioned for people ending a tour of the area as it is easily accessed from all directions. It has an immensely calm and peaceful atmosphere and has been constructed according to the architectural principles of Kerala Vastu. Along with yoga, spa treatments, long walks down the pristine beach, visits to local temples and villages, a stay here will allow you to gain an insight into local culture by way of fascinating evening lectures and cookery classes. Needless to say, the fresh seafood and mouth-watering local and international cuisine will have you longing for the next meal!

Being a member of Relais & Chateaux, the hotel is known for its exceptional cuisine and immensely friendly, warm, welcoming, gentle atmosphere.

Accessibility

By Air: To Mangalore followed by a 2.5 hour drive.

By Train: From Calicut, Cochin, Trivandrum, Tellicherry, Mangalore, Cannanore to Neeleshwar Town, followed by a 10 minute drive.

By Road: An easy drive from Tellicherry, Mysore, Coorg, Wynad, Cannanore, Calicut, Mangalore. A longer drive from Cochin, Nagarhole and Bangalore.

Transfers: The resort is happy to arrange limousine transfers (at extra cost) from either the airport or the railway station to / from the hotel.

Accommodation

Accommodation comprises traditional / Kerala style 16 thatched cottages (4 twin cottages and 8 single cottages) - 10 sea view rooms and 6 garden view rooms. All the rooms are convertible into single/twin/double, they are large, airy and wonderfully inviting, comfortable and spacious – each having its own, very private courtyard garden, balcony and bathroom. They are modern, slick and have superb mattresses and linens and furnishings and colour schemes. All of the rooms have overhead fans and air-conditioning. Hairdryers are provided. They have beautiful teak floors with rugs. All rooms have showers rather than a bath tub, a safe and internet connection. The shower is open to the skies at one end and covered for most of it. They boast large rainshowers and state of the art fixtures and fittings. Televisions and DVD players can be provided upon request. The rooms have wired and wireless connection which is free of charge, along with CD players / personal stereos. The hotel has a no smoking policy. The rooms are all on the ground floor and have easy access for wheelchairs. Bathrobes are provided in the rooms and complimentary filtered water is provided daily. All the cottages have a spacious and private verandah outside each one.

Dining

There is a main dining room in the centre of the resort called The Hermitage. Here local cooking skills join with Ayurvedic teaching on the importance of the appearance, balance, flavour, enjoyment and effects of a dish. Buffet and a la carte is available. Continental, classic Indian and local cuisine is served, which is predominantly vegetarian. There is also a delightful seafood and fish restaurant, by the pool and overlooking the beach.

Breakfast is included in the daily room rate.

Children

The resort accepts children of all ages. Children may be accommodated in their parent's bedroom for an extra charge (between the ages of 2 to 10 years old). Only one additional child per room is permitted. There is a baby sitting service available.

Dress code

There is no official dress code at Neeleshwar Hermitage. It is extremely relaxed and only beach clothes are required. Topless sunbathing is not allowed as it offends the locals.

Check-in / out time

Midday. Extended check-out is subject to negotiation/availability.

Electricity	220 volts. The standard two round pin adaptors work.
Credit cards / currency	The resort accepts Amex, Visa and MasterCard. If paying in foreign currency, the resort accepts US dollars, Sterling Pounds and Euros. Travellers cheques are also accepted.
Mobile telephones	Mobile telephones work here, on the local networks (Air Tel, Hutch, BSNL, etc).
When to go / Climate	There are no particular seasonal weather changes in Kerala as it benefits from a tropical climate and is warm and humid all year round. Being on the coast, the humidity is heightened. No warm clothes are necessary. It tends to rain in June and July and there can be sporadic showers in October. The best time to visit is from November to March. April is getting hot and May, August and September are very humid.
Opening and closing	The hotel remains open 365 days per year.
Pests	Being a coastal, tropical area, there can be mosquitoes. However, the sea breezes tend to minimize the mosquito problem. Should there be mosquitoes about, the rooms have mosquito repellents provided and mosquito coils are available for added protection when dining outside.
