Location

The fort sits in the middle of a lake and is blissfully peaceful and beautiful. It is reached by boat or by a small bridge (or by road right up to it when the lake is not full). It is fully staffed and everything is of the highest quality – from the beds, linen, toiletries and crockery to the furniture and cuisine. Each room has a private balcony and overlooks the lake. The central courtyard has a small pond in the middle during summer and this becomes a cosy fire s sitting area under cover and a superb, open air terrace overlooking the lake. There is also a Jacuzzi. It is small enough to be rented as a 'villa'. A highly personal place, with plenty of staff to attend to your needs at all times, whilst retaining its traditional, Rajasthani character. The perfect party venue or family holiday with every comfort you could wish for!

Accessibility

By Air: To Udaipur, from Delhi, Bombay, Jodhpur, Jaipur. Followed by a 3 hour car journey.

By Train: From Udaipur, Ajmer, Chittorgarh, 3 hour car journey. From Delhi to Ajmer and a 2 hour car journey. Deogarh 30 mins

By Road: An easy drive from DeviGarh, Narlai, Ghanerao, Nimaj, Kishangarh, Jodhpur, Rohet. A longer drive from Jaipur, Dungarpur, Bambora.

Transfers: The resort is happy to arrange transfers (at extra cost) from either the airport or the railway station to / from the hotel and has a luxurious taxi and in a vintage car (1964 Jaguar S Type / 1934 Chevy / 1942 GI Ford Jeep) on special request.

Accommodation	There are 4 deluxe suites. All rooms have internet access, hairdryers, safe, mini-bars and tea/coffee making facilities. 2 suites are air-conditioned and 2 have overhead fans and heating in the winter. One complimentary bottle of water is provided in each room, each day. Television in one suite. The suites are called Raag Megh Malhar, Raag Tilak Kamod, Raag Basant, Raag Darbari. Being all on the ground floor, there is easy access to the rooms and dining room and terrace for wheelchairs.
Dining	Dining here is a wonderful, memorable even and is inside round the cosy camp fires, on the inner terrace which has glass to protect from the wind, outside on the terrace or down on the lawns by the pool.
	Room Service – 24 hours
Meal Times	There are no set meal times.
Children	The resort accepts children of all ages. Children may be accommodated in their parent's bedroom for an extra charge. There is a baby-sitting service available.
Dress code	There is no official dress code. However, many find themselves changing into something a little tidier for dinner.
Check-in / out time	12.00 Extended check-out is subject to negotiation /availability.
Electricity	220 volts. The standard two round pin adaptors work.
Credit cards / currency	The resort accepts Visa and MasterCard. If paying in foreign currency, the resort accepts Indian Rupees, US dollars, Sterling Pounds and Euros. Travellers cheques are also accepted.
Mobile telephones	Mobile telephones work here on the BSNL, Reliance CDMA, and Hutch networks.
When to go / Climate	Rajasthan has some major climactic fluctuations. During December, January and February, it can be cold in the mornings and evenings and warm clothes are necessary at these times. During the daytime it is lovely and warm and sunny. March and April are getting fairly hot and it begins to get very hot in May and June and temperatures can rise to an intense heat. However the property is located at 2300 feet above sea level and remains cooler than most of the country (hottest temperature 37 C). The monsoon breaks in July and lasts until September. October and November are pleasantly warm but not wet. The best time to visit is from October to early April. Summer is generally a dry heat with very little humidity.

Opening and closing	The hotel remains open 365 days per year.
Pests	Due to the dry heat of Rajasthan, mosquitoes are not a major problem but they do tend to come out in the evenings and early mornings in the warmer months. All rooms have insect repellent and full insect protection screens on the windows. Coils are provided when dining outside, should anyone require one. The property has a pest control programme.
Hotel facilities	Complimentary Shuttle bus from Deogarh to Seeng Sagar Fully staffed. V Sat Internet connectivity through WI – FI and computer in shop for surfing and e mail. Swimming pool Jacuzzi Full use of the facilities at the sister hotel Deogarh Mahal
